

FOREIGN STUDENT AND INTERNATIONAL PRACTICES

The relevant institute's administrative board is authorized to determine the entrance requirements for international students.

Applications for graduate programs from Turkish and international candidates who completed their education at higher education institutions abroad recognized by the Council of Higher Education are decided upon by the relevant institute's administrative board, after consultation with the relevant department/branch head.

International students applying to doctoral programs must obtain a minimum score of 55 on the YDS (YDS) in a foreign language recognized by the Interuniversity Board, other than their native language, or an equivalent score on an exam recognized by the Interuniversity Board. The Senate may raise the minimum scores based on the characteristics of the graduate programs being applied to.

International students graduating from a higher education institution in Turkey are subject to the same requirements regarding the ALES score as Turkish nationals.

International students graduating from a higher education program abroad must present a Turkish proficiency certificate obtained from a university's Turkish language teaching center (TÖMER) or another recognized institution. Those who do not have a Turkish proficiency certificate may

attend a Turkish preparatory class at Nevşehir Hacı Bektaş Veli University TÖMER after admission and registration. They may also begin their master's or doctoral studies after receiving a Turkish proficiency certificate.

A Turkish proficiency certificate is not required for foreign language programs.
